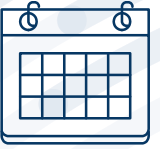

# Cohorts



**Cohort 1** - K-12 Students with Individualized Education Plans with an adapted curriculum; Pre-K students with IEPs

**Cohort 2** - Grades K & 1

November 2 - 6 - Kindergarten orientation

November 9 - Kindergarten return to in-person

November 16 - First grade return to in-person

**Cohort 3** - Grades 2 & 3 - Proposed (December 14)

**Cohort 4** - Grades 4 & 5 - Proposed (January 11)

**Cohort 5** - Grades 6 - 12 - TBD

# Grades 2-5 Survey

- Commitment of the instructional model for the remainder of the year
- Instructional model depends on the survey results
- The goal is to provide in-person learning 4 days per week - Dependent on space and staffing
- Student's teacher may change as a result of the choice
- Daily schedule will change as more cohorts are added
- Transportation routes will continue to change as cohorts are added
